*The Mississippi State Health Department charges an annual fee called a Water Quality Analysis Fee. This fee is paid annually for water quality testing that is done monthly, semi-annually, and annually through out the year to meet the Federal Safe Water Drinking Act. We do not include this fee in our rates as this fee is determined each year by the Water Quality Analysis Fee Committee and may go up or down. It is paid straight to the Mississippi State Health Department.

Eudora Utilities Association Policy and Procedure Appendix B

Water and Sewer Rate Review

- I. **POLICY:** It shall be the policy of the Eudora Utilities Association that water and sewer rates will be reviewed annually and presented to the Board of Directors for adjustments they deem appropriate. It is anticipated that the water and sewer rates shall be annually adjusted, at a minimum, by the same percentage as the Consumer Price Index for All Urban Consumers (published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics, Southeastern Regional Office, Atlanta, GA)
- II. **GENERAL:** The State of Mississippi must comply with requirements of the Federal Safe Drinking Water Act (SDWA). One requirement of the SDWA is that each state implement a Capacity Development Program to improve the technical, managerial and financial capacity of the state's drinking water systems. The Financial Capacity section of the Mississippi Department of Health-Division of Water Supply Capacity Assessment Rating form requires that a water system has an official adopted policy that rates be reviewed, and adjustments made as appropriate. This policy is intended to bring Eudora Utilities Association into compliance with that requirement.
- III. **PROCEDURE:** The Executive Director, in coordination with the Treasurer, will annually review the water and sewer rates for the Eudora Utilities Association. This shall be done as soon as reasonably possible after the audited financial statement for the previous Fiscal Year is received and the CPI percentage increase/decrease is known. After review, the rate analysis will be presented to the Board for their consideration and action.
- IV. **Conclusion:** This policy will help keep Eudora Utilities Association in compliance with MSDH regulations and give the Board an opportunity to review water and sewer rates in an effort to keep our system viable.
